








Network Overview








users










Coming Soon...


- Improved webcast
 - Synchronising all video sources to get rid of the picture breakup during transitions
 - Should help the steaming encoders and clients
 - Additional possibilities
- Virtualisation of servers
 - Almost ready for this meeting... but not quite
 - Reduce four Linux servers and two Windows servers to two mirrored virtual hosts
 - Reduced weight (cheaper shipping to "away" meetings)
 - Reduced heat generation (a cooler OPS Room)



Coming Soon...

- Improve Wireless LAN
 - more access points, low power micro-cells
- Improve Monitoring
 - flow analysis (IPv4/IPv6 and traffic type)
 - better fault detection
 - prettier graphs in this presentation :-)
- Improve power distribution in Plenary and WG rooms
