






 - In partnership with IDRC and ISOC.
 - Small grants program for funding ICT research projects
 - + 2nd phase.
 - Total amount for this second phase: US\$ 650,000
 - Total: More than U\$S 1 million in 4 years.



- It was the result of the Regional Conference of Governments, in 2005 (Río de Janeiro). eLAC-2007 includes 70 goals.
- eLAC-2007 process is runs by the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC)
- LACNIC has activities that directly contribute with the achievement of 25 of the eLAC-2007 objectives probing that LACNIC is an active actor in the development of the Information Society in our region.
- LACNIC usually participates in every eLAC2007 activities, working groups, etc. Specially in those working groups related to the technical stability of Internet
- We are very active in the new process eLAC-2010
