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RIPE NCC History

- Technical administration of the e164.arpa zone since 2002
 - Tier-0 ENUM registry
 - Following the IAB instructions http://www.ripe.net/enum/instructions.html
- Deployment of DNSSEC in the DNS we administer, end of 2005
 - RIPE NCC zones, reverse delegations for IPv4 and IPv6
 - 50+ zones signed, xx secure delegations
 - Mature infrastructure, operational and key maintenance procedures
- Next step e164.arpa
 - Informed the IAB (June 2007)
 - The IAB informed the ITU
 - The IAB endorsed the RIPE NCC proposal
 - Details in the correspondence http://www.iab.org/documents/correspondence/

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The plan

- Same operational and key maintenance procedures
- Sign the zone 26 November 2007
 - Publish the KSK
 - Key rollover twice a year
- Accept secure delegations (DS records) 25 March 2008
 - Provisioning system already supports this
- The plan was announced on 27 September 2007
 - ENUM-WG, DNS-WG





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
