About 100 hours

How long did it take the registrants?

It varied from network to network. But they...

- Audited their networks
- Scheduled maintenance slots
- Renumbered devices
- Had meetings and helped me investigate
- 5 minutes to 5 days work



How long did it take 3rd parties?

5 minutes to a few hours spread over a few days



Summary

- A /8 lasts about I month at current consumption rates
- Registry cost was about 6 mins per address
- 3½ hours per registration
- Low value addresses
- Prefixes longer than /24
- Not aggregated
- Former Class A space
